Saint of the Week - St. Maelruain

Maelruain was born in North Tipperary in 720 and founded a monastery in Tallaght in Southwest Dublin in 755. A Dominican Priory now stands on the same site. He was the leader of the Céilí Dé, a reform movement aimed at restoring purity and austerity to Irish monasticism which had become somewhat undisciplined by the 8th Century. St. Maelruain died in 792 and his feast day is celebrated on <u>**7**</u>th July</u>.

Gospel Reflection

(Mark 6: 1-6)

In today's Gospel we hear about Jesus returning to His hometown of Nazareth after performing the great miracles we have heard about in recent weeks, including the calming of the storm and the raising of Jairus' daughter from the dead. Despite these powerful signs and the teaching Jesus conveyed in His hometown's Synagogue, the people there still expressed disbelief. The main reason for their lack of faith was their close familiarity with Jesus. They could not understand that the "carpenter's son" whom they had seen grow up in their midst could be such an extraordinary prophet and even the Messiah.

Jesus guoted the Old Testament to illustrate what He experienced: "A prophet is only despised in his own country, among his own relations and in his own house." This can be true of our own experiences too. It can be difficult to witness to our faith among those who are closest to us. This

is often the case because emotions run high with family and close friends, especially if we disagree. Jesus Himself experienced the alienation of those closest to Him. If we are experiencing that too, just remember that Jesus can relate to our situation and provide strength and comfort to us.

Thank you, Lord, for the increased time we have to be with our friends and family, and for the more relaxed pace of the summer season. Draw us closer to You this Summer. Teach us how we can pray no matter where we are or what we are doing. Warm our hearts with the awareness of your presence and guide our path each day with your loving care. Amen.
