Gospel Reflection

In today's Gospel from Mark 6:7-13 we are told that Jesus sent out the Twelve who were selected from among His disciples who are also called "apostles." The word "apostle" means "one who is sent." The number twelve is also a symbolic number, representing the twelve tribes of Israel. By naming twelve apostles, Jesus shows his mission to be in continuity with the mission of God's people, Israel.

Jesus' instructions to the apostles are to preach, to share his authority to heal and to drive out demons. He sends them out in pairs and instructs them to travel lightly, without food, money or extra clothes. These instructions mean that the Twelve will be dependent on the hospitality of others, just as Jesus depended on others to provide for His needs.

Today, Jesus continues to send us too into the world as His disciples. But like the first disciples, we are not sent alone. Jesus has given us the community of the Church, which strengthens our life of discipleship. The Christian message can only truly be proclaimed in and through the community of faith that is the Church. In our work with others, we build this community of faith by inviting others to share in it.
