SAINT OF THE WEEK — ST ATTRACTA

Attracta was a 5th century saint and when St. Patrick founded a nunnery at Coolavin, near Lough Gara in south Co. Sligo he appointed Attracta as its first Abbess. She and her convent had a reputation for hospitality, charity to the poor and the gift of healing. St. Attracta is the co-patron saint along with St. Nathy of the Diocese of Achonry and Tourlestrane Parish Church in Sligo is dedicated to her. We celebrate her feast day on 12th August.
