Veni, Sancte Spiritus - Come, Holy Spirit

On this, the 50th Day after Easter we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, the Feast of the Holy Spirit - the Third Person of the Most Holy Trinity. This is the day on which the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles. This event also marks the beginning of the Church. Previously, Jesus had promised to send to his disciples a helper who would enable them to be His witnesses throughout the world. Now this promise is fulfilled, and they were no longer afraid and rushed out to proclaim the Good News to everyone they met.

The Holy Spirit brings us many gifts which we receive throughout our Sacramental lives. In our Baptism we are cleansed of sin and become Christians. In our Confirmation we are sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit and in the Sacrament of Reconciliation our sins are forgiven. He is the one true Spirit who is with us always. So today, let us honour and praise the Holy Spirit and may we be constantly aware of the abiding presence of God's Spirit in our lives so that we may truly be living temples of the Holy Spirit and instruments of renewal and transformation in the world.

PRAYER: Holy Spirit, You are God. I praise you because you are holy, and I thank you for dwelling in my heart. Thank you for working in my life. You guided me into salvation, renewed my dead spirit and you opened my eyes to the Truth. Help me to see you more clearly - to recognize your movement in my life. Make me more sensitive to you so I can follow you more closely. I need you to help me be obedient when I recognize your leading. I ask you for your help today. You know my pain and anxieties very well. Thank you for praying over me. Help me to rest in your comfort today and always. Amen.
