St. Mary's Parish Carrigallen – Drumeela – Drumreilly 02nd June 2024 – Corpus Christi Sunday - Year B



Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. It is a most joyful celebration of the abiding presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Devotion to the Blessed Sacrament flows from the heart of the Mass and the Holy Communion into which we enter in receiving Christ in the Eucharist. The Mass is the representation of the action of Jesus on the night before he died. During the Last Supper he took bread and wine, blessed it, broke it and gave Himself in these Sacramental signs to His disciples. "My Body, My Blood, given for you".

In those words and actions, Jesus pre-figured the greatest action of all the offering of Himself on the Cross. We believe and repeat that sacred action in obedience to His command each time the Church, gathered around the altar, remembers and puts back together again the broken Body of Christ. In the Eucharistic Sacrament which we celebrate today, the simplest of all human foods is transformed into the Body of Christ. Because we have shared in the Eucharist with each other, we are also called by Jesus to care for and serve each other. As we celebrate this feast day in memory of Jesus, may we also serve each other in His memory too.

Lord, let us pray for the willingness to make present in our world the love of Christ shown to us in the Eucharist. Lord Jesus, we worship you living among us in the Sacrament of your Precious Body and Blood. May we offer to our Father in heaven a solemn pledge of undivided love.
