RENOVATION WORKS TO ST. MARY'S CHURCH, DRUMEELA

Plans are at hand to put a new floor in the sanctuary of the church. The plywood has sagged between the rafters, causing the floor to become uneven. There are areas around some of the windows that need attention, also some areas of the Church walls inside. This means removing the plaster to replaster with lime which takes time to bond and dry.

This work will necessitate leaving the church for a number of weeks. We will move to Teach Dúchais as a temporary arrangement. This means inconvenience for everyone. I would appeal to parishioners from other areas of the parish to attend mass in their own Church and leave the Drumeela people and those attending anniversaries to attend in Teach Dúchais.

The work will begin this coming *Monday 17th June*. If and when there are funerals, we will arrange to have them celebrated in St. Mary's, Carrigallen. For Cemetery Sun. 14th July, we hope to have Mass outside with the Blessing of the Graves afterwards. We pray for a fine day.

DAY FOR LIFE - 16th JUNE 2024

BISHOP'S MESSAGE: There has been much discussion in the media recently about 'assisted suicide', whereby people who feel they are overburdened by suffering will be facilitated in bringing their lives to a premature end by a change in legislation. The Catholic Church opposes this. As Catholics, along with many people of other faiths and none, we share a different vision about what it is to be fully human, especially when we are suffering and approaching death in the hope of eternal life. People who are coming towards the end of their lives can feel vulnerable, and recent research shows that many consider themselves a burden on their loved ones and wider society.

Jesus shows us that life always has dignity and that there is no such thing as a useless life. We are called to defend this gift of life to its natural end and to protect vulnerable citizens from a culture that could pressure them into assisted suicide. We support people with the companionship of a listening ear, appropriate treatment, and the best of care, so that their last days can be times of grace, intimacy and love.

Jesus did not send the sick away. Our Lady remained at the foot of the Cross to the very end as Her Son, Jesus, died. Mary is the model of compassionate presence and prayer whom we are called to imitate. People close to death and their loved ones, often go through similar darkness and pain but can come to a more complete acceptance and find peace in those treasured last moments accompanied by spiritual care.
