CHARITY TAX FORMS 2023 - FINAL REMINDER

There are still a number of forms (CHY 3) outstanding in all 3 Church Areas. The forms were issued earlier this year to parishioners who donated €250 or more through the envelope collection system. To qualify for inclusion in this charity tax refund scheme, you must have paid tax under the PAYE System or Self-Assessment (Self-employed) system in 2023. Other taxes such as Deposit Interest Retention Tax (D.I.R.T.) do not qualify. By reclaiming tax on your donation, the Church as a registered Charity can increase the value of your donation/contribution by up to an additional 45%. It only takes a few minutes to complete the form and the completed forms are held securely in the Parish Office and not used for any other purpose. As this is an important source of Government income to the Parish, we appeal for your co-operation.
