GOSPEL REFLECTION (JOHN 6: 41-51)

In today's gospel, the Jews are squabbling about the origin of Jesus.

They know that He is the son of Mary and Joseph and therefore find it difficult to comprehend these words of Jesus - "I am the living bread, which has come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live forever, and the bread I give is my flesh for the life of the world." They use their doubts to discredit Jesus and the work He is doing. But Jesus remains fully focused on the subject and again repeats the aforementioned words to them. He also speaks of His inseparable relationship with the Father. He says that His mission is from the Father Himself and that any access to Him must be brought about by the Father. No one can claim to know the Son without also knowing the Father.

The good news for us today is that Christ draws us to himself every day through the Eucharistic to nourish and strengthen us for our earthly journey. He is the living bread that satisfies our spiritual hunger. He equally fills us with His Spirit, who directs us on the right path on our journey. The words of Jesus are as real today as when He first spoke them to the Jews two thousand years ago. So let us take advantage of this generous gift that God had given us through the Holy Eucharist to enrich our lives. In the words of today's psalm: "Taste and see that the Lord is good." He is the living bread of life. He is the Mystery of our faith and the life of the world.

Feast of the Assumption—Thurs 15th Aug 2024

On this feast we celebrate Mary, who was chosen to be the Mother of God. Mary was born without sin, she lived her life without sin and that is why the Church believes Mary was taken straight into heaven. Mary inspires us and challenges us to place our faith and trust in Jesus her Son just as she did.
