GOSPEL REFLECTION

(Mark 9: 30-37)

In today's Gospel, we hear that Jesus is now spending more time with His disciples than with the general public as He wants them to understand more about his pending death and resurrection. They still have doubts about what He has told them but to be on the safe side they argue among themselves about who should be first in line to replace Jesus in the event of His departure from them. Jesus tells them that in order to be first, one must make himself last of all and servant of all. Then Jesus puts His arms around a little child and tells them that anyone who welcomes one of these little children in His name, welcomes Him and anyone who welcomes Him, welcomes not Him but welcomes the Father who sent Him.

Therefore, by using a child as an example for us today, Jesus is simply teaching us that we have to become like children in order to be great. Of course, this does not mean being childish. Rather, it means being child-like. It means that we have to live our lives in humble service to God and to one another. To be great is to be focused on something other than oneself, and to have the ability to accommodate, welcome, and work in harmony with others just as children always do. It also means the readiness to accept the truth and to reflect positively on it.
