GOSPEL REFLECTION (Mark 9: 38-43, 45, 47-48)

In today's Gospel, we hear that the disciples are not happy because they saw a man—who was not a disciple—cast out evil spirits. They are jealous as they think they are in quite a privileged position in being closely associated with Jesus and that no one else should be performing miracles in their Master's name. But Jesus tells them not to stop the man and that whoever is not against them is for them. So, the message or warning to us is that we should not prevent anyone or put obstacles in their way from trying to bring people closer to the boundless love of God.

Further on in the Gospel, Jesus is telling us that if something that is part of our life is causing us to sin or has become a problem, we may need to make drastic changes or at least try new approaches. So, this week let us focus on any aspects of our lives that may need to be pruned in order that we can flourish in our faith and come closer to our God.

GOD WALKS WITH HIS PEOPLE

"God walks with His people" is the title chosen by Pope Francis for his Message for the World Day of Migrants and Refugees (WDMR) 2024 which is celebrated today. In this message, the Holy Father reminds us that all of us, God's people, are migrants on this earth, on our way to the "true homeland", the Kingdom of Heaven. Migrants are a contemporary icon of this people on a journey, of the Church on a journey, and at the same time, it is in them and in all our vulnerable brothers and sisters that we can encounter the Lord who walks with us.
