### THE RELICS OF ST. BERNADETTE

Why are relics significant and why are they coming to our Diocese? During the 13<sup>th</sup> Apparition, the Virgin Mary asked Bernadette, "Go and tell the priests to build a chapel here and that people should come in procession." Bernadette thus became the Virgin Mary's missionary, passing on her request to the parish priest of Lourdes. Today, the Sanctuary Our Lady of Lourdes wants to respond to this request in a new way. This is an opportunity to have Lourdes come to you and experience the pilgrimage in Lourdes at home in Ireland. Like Bernadette, we want to:

• bear witness and proclaim that God is near and that in him every life can be open to the happiness of the other world today.

• encourage a spirit of prayer and hope by helping all the faithful to rekindle the strength and dynamism of their Christian life and devotion to Mary.

• replicate the pilgrimage to Lourdes because the Virgin invites us to come here in procession to draw on the source of God's powerful mercy and his action on behalf of humanity.

This visit is an opportunity and a way to share the grace of an encounter with Mary, as Bernadette experienced it, to find in this encounter peace and joy of heart and to become credible and courageous witnesses of love. This is a chance for people in our Diocese to *'have the experience of Lourdes'* especially those who through infirmity or advance age, may not be able to make the trip to southern France. St. Bernadette was born on 7<sup>th</sup> Jan. 1844 & died on 16<sup>th</sup> April 1879. Is buried in Nevers and was canonized on 8<sup>th</sup> Dec. 1933. Her visions led to the founding of the Marian Shrine of Lourdes.

The Relics will be arriving at the Cathedral of St. Patrick and St. Felim, Cavan on this *Monday 28<sup>th</sup> Oct. at 9.45 am* with Mass at 10.00 am. Stations of the Cross at 1.00 pm & Anointing of the Sick at 3.00 pm. A Penitential Service at 5.00 pm with Confessions until 6.45 pm. Mass at 7.00 pm, Holy Hour at 8.00 pm and Veneration until 10.00 pm. The Relics will proceed to St. Clare's Church, Manorhamilton on *Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> October*.
