24th Nov. 2024 – Solemnity of Christ the King - Year B

**<u>Reflection</u>**: On this, the last Sunday in the Liturgical Year, we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. The usual idea of kingship is of an all-powerful ruler, controller and dictator but Jesus' actions have made it clear that he is not that kind of king. He has not come to 'lord' it over people. He is not interested in an earthly type of kingdom. His kingdom is very different - it is not of this world. It is not simply that Jesus had spoken about a different place. His words and deeds presented a different way of living, one that is not about control or power but love and service. Jesus' power comes from God, and it is a power that builds people up rather than diminishes them. He doesn't deny that He is a king, but it is not the word He would use. The only thing that matters to Him is the truth and that truth is God.

Those who belong to God listen to the voice of Jesus, the servant king, and follow His example. We live in extremely difficult times for the Church and for the world. The message of this feast is that we have a hope-filled future and that things will get better if we can only open ourselves to the teaching, life and rule of our Universal King, Jesus the Christ, God's Suffering Servant.
