REFLECTION

On this, the Third Sunday of Advent, also known as Gaudete or Rejoicing day, we light the pink or rose-coloured candle on the Advent Wreath which is known as the Shepherd's Candle and represents the joy felt at the birth of our Lord, as well as the joy we have in anticipation of His return. In her song of joy, the Virgin Mary says that "All generations will call me blessed." Faith is a blessing, something to be thankful for because it allows us to rejoice in so many things given to us by God. Our families and friends, the beauty of the world, the wonder of music, of stories and of created things. The Lord has created us for joy and has shared his life with us so that we may enjoy being alive. As we think of the joyful message of the angels, 'Glory to God in the highest', we allow this message of sheer joy to cut through the stress and pressure that this time of year can bring. In today's Gospel (Luke 3: 10 - 18) the crowds question John the Baptist about what evidence of repentance is required? John replies by naming concrete actions: crowds should share their food and cloaks; tax collectors should be just; soldiers should act fairly. When the crowd begins to wonder if John the Baptist might be the Messiah, John explains how he baptises with water but that someone more powerful coming after him will baptise with the Holy Spirit and fire. John's ministry is in preparation for the Messiah and he also knows his place and role in God's plan of salvation. By encouraging the crowd to act similarly in accordance with their stations in life, John's teaching suggests that each person has a role to play in God's salvation. It is the great mystery of our salvation that God permits and even asks for human cooperation in His divine plans.

A DVENT PRAYER FOR JOY—Heavenly Father, let all who take refuge in You be glad; let us always *sing for joy*. Please fill me with joy in Your presence, with eternal pleasures at Your right hand. Grant that as Jesus promised, His joy may be in us and our joy may be complete. Fulfill His promise that, though we may grieve, *our grief will turn to joy*, and no one will take away our joy. Teach us to always pray with joy, giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of His holy people in the kingdom of light. And grant us such love and faith in You that we may be filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy. *Amen*.
