A new additional Grant of €50 per 10 trees per km has been introduced to encourage the cutting of dangerous overhanging tree canopies/branches along the public road. REFLECTION

On this, the Second Sunday of Advent, we light the second purple candle of Advent Wreath which is known as the Bethlehem Candle and symbolizes peace. This candle reminds us that the angels declared "peace on earth" at the birth of Jesus. Jesus offers us inner peace and peace with others. We can know and experience peace today only through the life of Jesus Christ. The world awaits the birthday of the Prince of Peace and the gift of peace. Today so many people suffer war and violence. Leaders threaten, armies wage war and the innocent die; especially women and children. Local wars and disputes bring bloodshed and terror to the streets and towns of our global village. It affects us all for in the end 'no man is an island.' The message of the Prince of Peace is needed now more than ever. We pray for love and forgiveness, peace and reconciliation to restore harmony between human beings so that future generations may live in safety.

Today's Gospel (Luke 3: 1-6) invites us to prepare a way for the Lord in the wilderness of our lives — or perhaps better to allow God to prepare a way in our hearts for His coming. Advent reminds us that we are on a journey and that the Lord will come to each of us personally at our journey's end. We have come from the hand of God — he loved us and called us into being —each one is personally known and loved, and we journey through life until the moment when He calls us back to Himself. Advent strengthens our hope that He will come — and invites us to be ready and on the watch. If we learn to recognise His coming at each moment, then when He finally comes for us, we will recognise Him and surrender to His embrace.

ADVENT PRAYER FOR PEACE—God of Heaven, at the first Christmas Your angel announced, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to men of goodwill." Thank You for the peace Your Son Jesus promised, not as the world gives, but willing, deep, lasting, and abiding peace. Thank You, that since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. May the Lord of peace Himself give us peace at all times and in every way. *Amen.*


