REFLECTING ON OUR BAPTISM

Today is an opportunity for all of us to reflect on our own baptism. It is not something which happened a long time ago and which 'made' us Catholics. It is not just a ceremony lasting a few minutes which produces magical effects. Rather, it is the beginning of a lifelong journey. It is the beginning of a process of growing into the Body of Christ as one of its members.

Our baptism is essentially a community experience; it is not just a private or a family event, although in the way it was "celebrated" it may have looked like that. It involves active participation in the life of the Church, not just passive membership and not asking what the Church can do for you, but what you can do for the Church.

Each one of us is called to be a living witness to the Gospel - to be the salt of the earth, a city on a hill, a lamp radiating light for all. Our baptism is a never-ending call to follow in the footsteps of Jesus. Every word of Isaiah can also be applied to each one of us who has been baptised. So let us today renew our faith in and our commitment to following Jesus. Let us re-affirm our readiness to carry on his work. For it is a sobering fact that without our co-operation, much of God's work will never get done.

PRAYER: Lord, thank you for the precious gift of baptism, that we can publicly declare our love and passion for You. We ask for Your goodness and blessings to be poured out on us. We pray that You would work deeply within our hearts and souls to renew and refresh us each day. Amen.
