GOSPEL REFLECTION

In today's Gospel (Luke 6: 39-45) we hear that the blind cannot lead the blind. And a disciple cannot be good unless he or she has learned from the teacher. Everyone who is fully trained is like the teacher who knows how to cure the blind. Before you can be a good disciple and teach others you must take care of yourself. Do not try to take a speck out of your brother's eye until you have taken the board out of your own. Only when you have purified yourself can you produce the good works that the teacher requires. Discipleship asks us to produce good deeds. But to produce them requires the integrity and purity of heart found in the teacher. When people see your good deeds, they will know that this is because you have a good heart.

Jesus is asking us to put our own house in order first before trying to reform others. This is a very appropriate invitation to all of us as we are about to begin the Holy season of Lent, an observeance of 40 days fasting and penance. It occurs during Springtime, & we are reminded to do some spring-cleaning and stocktaking in our lives, and enjoy new life as a result. It's a time to leave the trappings of sin behind us and to grow closer to the Lord.
